Toy Breeds	The Doubling Method Double the weight at 6 weeks, then double it again.	 Weigh puppy at 6 weeks. Double the 6-week weight. Double it again to get the adult weight.
Small Breeds	Growth Rate Formula Find the growth rate and multiply by 52.	 Weigh puppy. Divide current weight by age in weeks. Multiply growth rate by 52.
Medium Breeds	Growth Rate Formula Same as small breeds	 Weigh puppy. Divide current weight by age in weeks. Multiply growth rate by 52.
	Method 2: Multiply the weight at 14 weeks by 2, then add half the weight at 14 weeks.	 Weigh puppy at 14 weeks. Multiply weight by 2. Add half the 14-week weight to the total.
Large & Giant Breeds	Method 1: Use the growth rate formula at 20 weeks.	 Weigh puppy at 20 weeks. Divide Current weight by age in weeks. Multiply growth rate by 52.
	Method 2: Double the weight at 6 months	 Weight puppy at 6 months. Multiply weight by 2.
