

Puppy Adult Weight Prediction Methods by Breed Size

Breed Size	Formula Description	Calculation Steps
Toy Breeds	<p>The Doubling Method</p> <p>Double the weight at 6 weeks, then double it again.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Weigh puppy at 6 weeks. 2. Double the 6-week weight. 3. Double it again to get the adult weight.
Small Breeds	<p>Growth Rate Formula</p> <p>Find the growth rate and multiply by 52.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Weigh puppy. 2. Divide current weight by age in weeks. 3. Multiply growth rate by 52.
Medium Breeds	<p>Growth Rate Formula</p> <p>Same as small breeds</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Weigh puppy. 2. Divide current weight by age in weeks. 3. Multiply growth rate by 52.
	<p>Method 2:</p> <p>Multiply the weight at 14 weeks by 2, then add half the weight at 14 weeks.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Weigh puppy at 14 weeks. 2. Multiply weight by 2. 3. Add half the 14-week weight to the total.
Large & Giant Breeds	<p>Method 1:</p> <p>Use the growth rate formula at 20 weeks.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Weigh puppy at 20 weeks. 2. Divide Current weight by age in weeks. 3. Multiply growth rate by 52.
	<p>Method 2:</p> <p>Double the weight at 6 months</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Weight puppy at 6 months. 2. Multiply weight by 2.
